



BENEFITS OF A MEDICAL FORENSIC EXAMINATION FOR A SEXUAL ASSAULT

- A medical forensic exam supports your health and collects evidence that may be used in a legal investigation.
- The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) provides compassionate, trauma-informed care with your physical and emotional well-being as the top priority.
- The SANE is specially trained in sexual assault response and skilled in sensitive, thorough evidence collection.
- You have up to 120 hours after an assault to decide whether to receive an exam, giving you time to make the choice that's right for you.
- You have the options to receive an exam, and have it tested without reporting to law enforcement if you are 18 or older.
- The SANE offers clear guidance on your options, supporting your decisions at every step.
- Your safety, dignity, and autonomy are always respected.

Sexual Assault Statistics

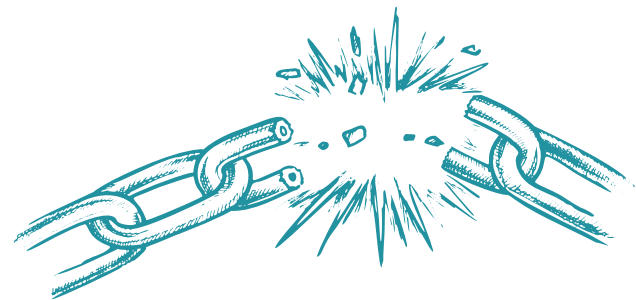
- 80% of sexual assaults are committed by a perpetrator known or related to the victim.
- 2 in 5 women and 1 in 5 men have been sexually assaulted in Texas.
- 6.3 million Texans have experienced some form of sexual assault in their lifetime.
- Over 90% of sexual assault survivors in Texas do not report to law enforcement.
